



LANDSCAPE

Context

- Criminalization of same sex intimacy, and sex work
- No anti-Discrimination legislation
- No gender recognition
- High level of discrimination against key populations – 93% approve buggery law.
- High levels of violence against women.
- High levels of self-stigma – 53% PLHIV in Stigma Index reported feeling guilty.
- Proposal to criminalize HIV transmission

Response

- Enabling Environments and Human Rights Technical Working Group
- Jamaica Anti-Discrimination System (JADS)
- Civil Society Forum
- Community-led organizations of PLHIV and WLHIV
- GFATM matching funds

Opportunities

- New National Strategic Plan 2020-2025
- New GFATM country dialogue

ACHIEVEMENTS

1. Developed five-year operational plan on enabling environments and human rights.
2. Strengthened monitoring mechanism.
3. Case for new GF grant for Jamaica.
4. Reactivated Technical Working Group on EEHR and Legal and Policy Review Committee.
5. Mobilizing political commitment.
